



# Cockroach Prep Sheet

## Important Info:

- Everyone (including pets) needs to be out of the house for at least 6 hours following the spray.
- Anyone who is pregnant, has health issues (especially heart or lung issues), or is under the age of 4 needs to be out for 24 hours.
- The chemical is a contact poison that is effective for up to 30 days. Don't wash it off to help the spray be as effective as possible.
- SDS sheets are available for download on our website.

## How to prepare:

- Move all furniture, including the fridge and stove, at least 2 feet away from the walls.
- Empty all cupboards in the kitchen and bathroom. Items can be placed on a table and covered with a sheet.
- Don't leave any open food in the kitchen.
- Remove all items from closet floors.
- Don't leave any items loose on the floor.
  - **Especially toys.** Bag them up or put them in a bin/chest.
- For extreme infestations, remove all light switch covers and electrical plug covers (call us if you're not sure this applies or not).

## After the spray:

- Open windows and doors for 15-20 minutes when you get back to air it out.
- It is normal to see more cockroaches after the initial spray as the chemical is driving them out of hiding.
- Dispose of any bodies you find on a regular basis. Just because the adults are dead doesn't mean the eggs are, so you don't want to risk them hatching.
- Second treatments are typically 10-15 days after the first treatment.
